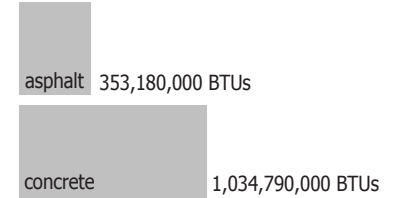

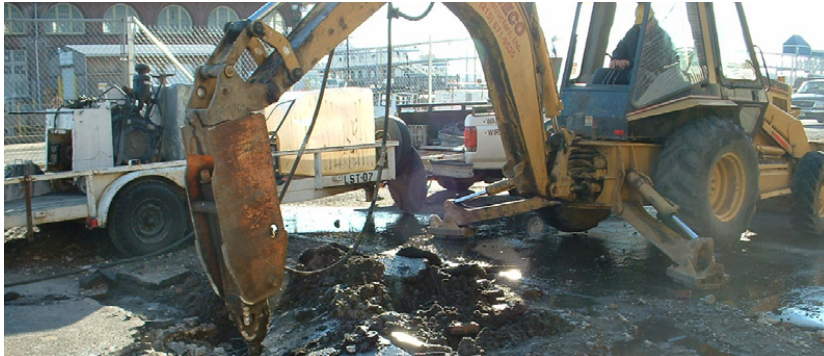


COUNT

PROBE

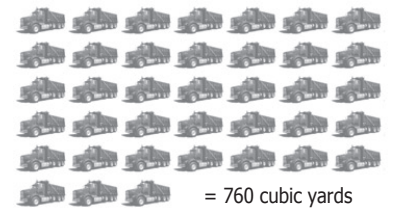
